Our Elementary Worship Team leads us in worship during chapel, and pastors bring messages that emphasize our yearly chapel theme.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

VCES offers a complete and excellent range of academics designed to prepare students to excel in Middle and High School. All teachers offer tutoring times during the week to assist students or to answer questions. And we use PowerSchool, an online program that helps parents monitor their student's course work, grades, and attendance. Pull-out classes include Library, PE, Art, Vocal Music, Band, and Computers, and resource classes are available through an on-site independent contractor for students needing extra help in reading. GATE classes, are available for eligible students as an after school program, in 3rd -5th grades.

TECHNOLOGY

Technology is strongly emphasized at VCES. Each classroom is equipped with a SMART Board. Elementary Computer Lab is used weekly, tablets for each student in all 1st - 3rd grade classrooms, and a mobile iPad cart that all 4th and 5th grade classes use. Classrooms feature computers for AR testing and the Elementary library is equipped with computers as well.

EXTENDED CARE/ENRICHMENT CLASSES

Extended Care is available before and after school, with the option to enroll in our Enrichment classes. Enrichment courses offered are classes such as Robotics, Culinary Arts, Mini Musicals, Pottery, Guitar, Science Lab, Painting, Drawing, and Gardening.

EXTRA CURRICULAR

We are proud to offer clubs, sports, and events that further develop our students leadership skills, sportsmanship, athleticism, and character. These extra curricular activities include Sports, Worship Team, Prayer Team, Student Council, Post Office, Newspaper, Choir, Speech Meet, and Spelling Bee.

Our middle school facilities include 16 beautiful classrooms equipped with SMART Boards, two well-equipped science labs, a 28-unit computer lab, a small Mac lab, media technology center, radio/TV station, multi-purpose facility, a band rehearsal room with 3 practice studios, Mission's garden, and a fully staffed kitchen with a hot lunch program. Our athletic facilities include football and soccer fields, baseball and softball fields, a full-court basketball gymnasium, a second full-size basketball court, a weight room, and spacious locker rooms.

OUR FACULTY

Our faculty is comprised of highly qualified and dedicated Christian educators, 40% having advanced degrees, who are committed to VCS's written philosophy, mission, vision, and core values. They engage in ongoing professional development that promotes sustained growth for themselves, their students, and for VCS's academic programs as a whole.

SPIRITUAL EMPHASIS

We integrate biblical truths into every subject area. Daily, our students are taught a Biblical world-view with the Bible being the authority on morality. All students have daily Bible classes, weekly chapels, and weekly small-group Bible studies led by teachers supplement the Christian growth experience. Our Chapel Leadership band leads worship during chapels, and a pastoral team shares the speaking schedule. Annually, we have a fun-filled, themed, Spiritual Retreat held at Koinonia Conference Grounds. This event provides a strong spiritual and relational impact and is the highlight of the year for many students.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

VCMS offers an extremely well-rounded academic program designed to prepare students to excel in high school and beyond. Advanced courses are offered in math and English, and an after-school tutoring program is available, at no charge, to all middle school students. We offer 15 different electives, and all of our middle school students use iPads daily. Students use Moodle, a learning-management system, to access uploaded coursework, PowerPoint presentations, and videos. We use PowerSchool, a web-based program that enables parents and students to check assignments, grades, and attendance online. Students are evaluated annually with national standardized tests and regularly perform three to four years above national norms.

Our athletic facilities include football and soccer fields, baseball and softball fields, full-court basketball gymnasium, a second full-size basketball court, a weight room, and spacious locker rooms.

OUR FACULTY

Our faculty is comprised of highly qualified and dedicated Christian educators who are committed to VCS's written philosophy, mission, vision, and core values. They engage in ongoing professional development that promotes sustained growth for themselves, their students, and for VCS's academic programs as a whole. Our Advanced Placement (AP) teachers are trained through the AP Institute.

SPIRITUAL EMPHASIS

We integrate biblical truths into every subject area. Daily, our students are taught a Biblical world-view with the Bible being the authority on morality. All students have daily Bible classes, bi-weekly chapels, and weekly small-group Bible discussions led by staff and clubs with biblical themes supplementing the Christian growth experience. Our Chapel Leadership students lead us in worship and local pastors present chapel messages. Annually there is a spiritual retreat, held at Alliance Redwoods Christian Conference

Grounds. Every year, a great many students make decisions to be more committed to their walk with Christ, and some accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior for the first time.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

VCHS offers a complete and excellent range of academics designed to prepare students to excel at the university level. Our graduation requirements are specifically designed to meet and exceed the California A-G requirements for admission to a California State or a University of California campus. We have eighteen Advanced Placement classes, and all teachers offer tutoring a minimum of three times throughout the week to assist students or to answer questions. We offer a wide variety of electives in the areas of Visual and Performing Arts, Practical Arts, and general electives, as well as Spanish, and French. Students use Moodle, a learning-management system, to access uploaded coursework, PowerPoint presentations, and videos. We use PowerSchool, a web-based program that enables parents and students to check assignments, grades, and attendance on-line. We are in year six of our one-to-one integration of iPads and Moodle within the high school.

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS

For the last six years, 99 percent of our graduates attend college. Approximately 81 percent attend four-year universities, while the rest are attending two-year colleges. Six years ago, we opened a new College Resource Center in the high school that is full of helpful information for our students, and college representatives visit often. We sponsor College Application Boot Camps, offer grade-level-specific college-preparatory workshops for students and their parents, on campus SAT/ACT professional preparatory courses, and provide individual college counseling to our students beginning in 8th grade.
