VCS Safety Statement

We are aware of the challenges and threats facing our students and society as a whole, from bullying to alcohol and drug use. In order to create a safe, stable place where children feel they belong:

- We have a zero tolerance policy for drugs and alcohol.
- We have an anti-bullying policy in place. We're aware bullying is a growing problem in all schools, and our pledge is to be ahead of the curve in training our staff to prevent bullying before it ever begins.
- Internet safety is important to us. We follow protocols in our classrooms and guide parents to websites detailing best practices.
- VCS provides on campus security during normal school hours. The security guard regularly patrols the entire campus.
- VCS has a camera equipped keyless entry system in the high school and in the elementary school.
- Our school regularly confers with local fire and police departments to ensure we are trained in best practices. Students regularly participate in all types of safety drills.

Established Drill Intervals -All School/Staff

- Fire Drill- Kinetic Monthly
- Earthquake Drill- Kinetic 2x Annually (Beginning and Mid School Year)
- HOLD- Kinetic 2x Annually (Beginning and Mid School Year)
- SECURE- Kinetic 2x Annually (Beginning and Mid School Year)
- LOCKDOWN- Kinetic 2x Annually (Beginning and Mid School Year)
- EVACUATE- Conceptual Annually (Tabletop Exercise w/School Administrators-Training conducted at individual school level w/faculty)
- SHELTER- Kinetic 2x Annually (Beginning and Mid School Year)




Automated Messaging

- Emergent notification will be sent to the community via SMS and Email




Automated Messaging: Unverified Threat to School


Automated Messaging: Credible Threat to School


Automated Messaging: Non-Credible Threat to School



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Automated Messaging: Threat Cancelled









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
Automated Messaging: LOCKDOWN








Automated Messaging: EVACUATION ORDER



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Automated Messaging: REUNIFICATION ORDER




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Perimeter Fencing and Guard Shack Entry Control Point (ECP)

- PHASE ONE: Physical barrier at GUARD SHACK to force vehicle and foot traffic to stop and engage guard on duty.
- Guard post orders and school front office protocols adjusted to facilitate visitor identification and access to schools after SCHOOL START TIME
- Add panic bar exit capability to EE fence gate doors (Exterior facing locked at all times)
- PHASE TWO: Integrate BLDGS 15 (4/5th Grade),16 (Gym) and 18 (Chapel Leadership) into EL existing perimeter fencing
- Create new perimeter fencing for ALL MIDDLE SCHOOL
- Create vehicle gate between EL and MS campuses to facilitate vehicle traffic to Falcon Field for sporting/other events
- Perimeter fencing to surround BLDG 17 (Multi Purpose Room/Conservatory)
- Estimated cost \$55,000.00 Option 1 / \$10-15k Option 2



Proposed Fencing Line Option 1


GREEN- Existing Fence Line

RED- Proposed New Fencing

GREEN/RED- Increase height to 6 ft

GREEN- Existing Fence Line

ORANGE - 8ft Vehicle/Pedestrian gate

GREEN/RED- Increase height to 6 ft

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Increase/Improve Camera Surveillance

- Currently 16 cameras on campus (9 Main Campus, 7 High School)
- In contact with several vendors f/pricing and options
- Integrate additional 16 cameras into currently fielded system (32 cameras total)
- Estimated Upfront Cost for 5 years of support/capability: \$15,624.00 (\$3124.00 annually)



Gunfire Detection Systems

- Ability to detect sound and infrared signature of a discharged firearm
- Real time notification and dispatch to local law enforcement
- Real time notification to campus staff to action SRP LOCKDOWN protocol
- In contact with several vendors for pricing and options
- Estimated cost ranges from \$55,000 to \$175,000



<u>Upgrade/Replace Current Radios</u>

- Current radio system is reaching life expectancy; dead zones
- New system would integrate into IT network via WiFi and cellular LTE simultaneously
- Real time notification to campus staff to action all SRP protocols
- In contact with several vendors for pricing and options
- Estimated cost ranges from \$18,000 to \$30,000
- Also exploring using same system as VUSD to leverage existing responder network (PD, Fire)
